### £1.5k Apprenticeship Grants



Apprenticeship grants referred to as "Age 16 to 24" for eligible employers are available with an individual value of £1500.

To be eligible for the grant, you must be able to confirm that:

- You are not able to employ the apprentice without "Age 16 to 24" support
- Haven't started an employee as an apprentice in the last 12 months
- Commit to employ the apprentice for a minimum of 12 months
- Agree to pay the apprentice at least the legal minimum.
